Faronika is a company owned by the Tolmin Fishing Club, specialized in breeding native fish species from the Soča River basin. In a modern fish farm located at the confluence of the Soča and Tolminka rivers, they raise marble trout, grayling, and produce high-quality fish products, all made with great respect for nature.



On the way from Faronika to Tolmin, the bus will make a stop at a service station for participants to buy lunch. But it is highly recommended that you **bring your own lunch with you.**



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The Tolmin Gorge is a common name for the Tolminka and Zadlaščica Gorges, which are one of the most magnificent natural attractions in Tolmin. They are the entry point into the Triglav National Park.



The circular path leads through the wild gorges of Tolminka and Zadlaščica, which merge into the only confluence in the gorges in Slovenia. See note below on the level of "fitness" required.

Difficulty: The path is steep in places with quite a few stairs. In case of rain, the path can be slippery. Appropriate walking (hiking) shoes are mandatory.

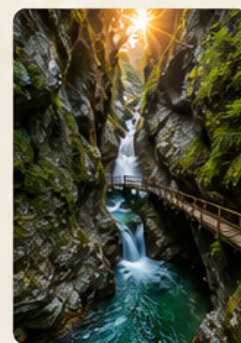
